

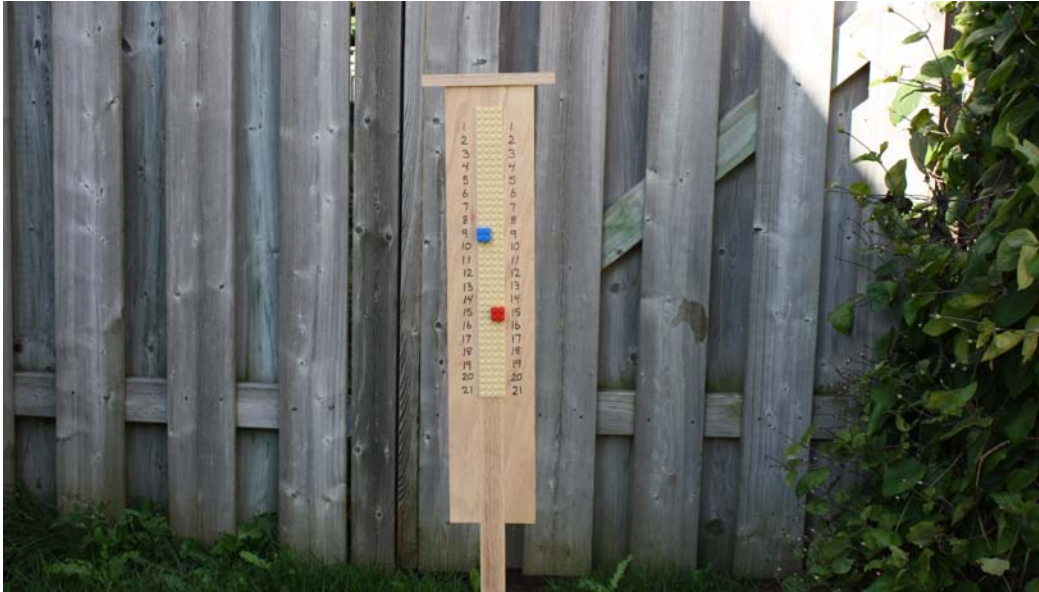
Lego Score Tower Instructions

Here is my scoreboard that I use around my place.

It consists of materials that most of us who have children already have - LEGO- the darn stuff that you always seem to step on!

All of these following steps and sizes are subject to your own requirements.



Dimensions and materials

- 40" or so x 4" of lumber (oak, pine etc.)
- 6" of capping (same material as above)
- 12" or so of a steel rod, threaded stock etc.
- 2 "U" nails
- 1 1/8" x 13 3/4" strip of LEGO
- 2 small blocks of LEGO for markers

Begin by cutting stock to length. Glue LEGO Strip to centre of wood (contact cement works great)

Number 1-21 down both sides of strip

Sharpen one end of steel rod (goes in ground)

From the backside, nail the steel rod to your wood by using 2 "U" nails

Stick scoreboard in ground

Using the LEGO blocks as scoring men, you are all set to play.
